From community outreach programs to capacity-building initiatives, Bilaad Development Trust (BDT) has remained steadfast in our mission to uplift and transform lives. Guided by our three focal areas of **Education**, **Entrepreneurship**, and **Change Advocacy**, we have worked tirelessly to create opportunities, empower communities, and advocate for positive transformation through community-driven projects and programs.

With a population of over 200 million and low human development index of 0.548 (UNDP 2024 HDI report), the social issues abound in Nigeria require concerted collaborative efforts to address. From the dearth of enablers in the Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises - MSME space, to the over 18 million out of school children, over 60% of whom are the girl child (africannews.com 2024), or issues regarding gender mainstreaming in the political landscape, Bilaad Devlopment Trust is committed to continuous collaboration with multi-disciplinary stakeholders to confront these threatening social and development concerns.

This report captures the highlights of projects and programs that BDT designed and deployed in 2024.

We express sincere gratitude to well-wishers, collaborators, eco-system and funding partners for their relentless support throughout the course of our journey. We also urge stakeholders in the public and organized private sectors to take a stand, get involved and stay involved.





2024 Key Highlights and Impact Areas:

Education

- The 2024 edition of our Gem Hunt Series event themed "Battle of the Tech Geniuses: unleashing future innovators" focused on the education sector, specifically targeting secondary school students.
- Participants showcased innovative ideas to improve education in Nigeria through technology.
- BDT also facilitated scholarships in American Universities and Colleges for high-fliers in Nigerian tertiary institutions drawn from underserved and under-privileged communities.



2024 Key Highlights and Impact Areas:

Entrepreneurship

- BDT conducted several training sessions for young entrepreneurs across Nigeria, 80% of whom are female, equipping them with essential skills to grow and sustain their businesses.
- BDT also provided funding support in form of grants to help these entrepreneurs drive their ventures and foster economic development.
- BDT delivered soft skills training for employability in blue-collar jobs.
- BDT also provided technical and mentoring support to female entrepreneurs, to further deepen their capacity and competence in managing their businesses.









2024 Key Highlights and Impact Areas:

Change Advocacy

- BDT actively with is engaging organizations such as the Nigerian Armed Forces, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Agency Nigeria of (SMEDAN) and other numerous collaborators to address nagging social issues, primarily socio-economic challenges and security concerns. This strategic collaboration demonstrates BDT's commitment to creating lasting positive change through partnerships with identified critical stakeholders in our society.
- Through these alliances, BDT is actively working to promote global development goals, gender mainstreaming through joint campaigns, awareness-raising initiatives, and policy advocacy efforts.





Other Projects and Interventions

- Bilaad Development Trust recognizes the importance of supporting society's most vulnerable members. Our dedicated interventions bring hope and practical assistance to underprivileged communities through carefully designed outreach programs such as:
- Annual Ramadan Feeding Program This program ensures that vulnerable families and individuals can break their fast with nutritious meals, embodying the spirit of compassion and community support.
- Annual Charity Outreach to Orphanages This program provides vital support to orphanages, delivering essential supplies, and creating moments of joy for children who need it most.



Other Projects and Interventions

- Understanding the devastating impact of environmental catastrophes on vulnerable communities, BDT gave support to affected communities especially during emergency periods.
- This commitment was demonstrated through our targeted interventions following the flooding disasters in Maiduguri, Borno State and Gamawa, Bauchi State. These initiatives provided crucial assistance to affected communities, helping families rebuild and recover in the aftermath of these devastating events.





Other Projects and Interventions

• BDT was made aware of the increasing widowed population in **Mbayeah**, **Ushongo**, **Benue State** through a female entrepreneur from Cohort 1 of our entrepreneurship training program who hails from the community. This prompted our initial outreach to the community, which will be followed by an Empowerment Initiative aimed at promoting sustainability and self-reliance for the widows, by leveraging their vocational and subsistence activities.
